Jonathan Noe has been named Vice President and Chief Lending Officer for Central Kentucky Ag Credit and he will be based at the association's Administrative Office in Lexington. He will be responsible for credit supervision and the overall credit and appraisal functions within the association's 17-county service area.

A graduate of Eastern Kentucky University with a B.S. Degree in Agriculture and a minor in Business, Jonathan has served in several capacities during his work with Ag Credit. He started service at the Richmond Ag Credit Branch during February 2002, then transferred to the association's Stanford Branch in January 2004. Jonathan worked as a loan officer at the Richmond Branch and as assistant vice president and branch manager at the Stanford location. During his service with the association he has also completed two major rural appraisal training programs.

His work as chief lending officer for the association has already started. At the current time, he is also completing his work and subsequent transition from the Stanford Branch.

Jonathan also farms on a small scale, by raising 15-20 feeder steers annually. His community service includes membership on the Garrard County Cattlemen's Association Board of Directors and on the Garrard County University of Kentucky Extension Board.

Jonathan and his wife, the former Keri LeeAnn Ledford of Garrard County, are both natives of the county and will continue to reside in Garrard County. They are parents of a 2-year-old son, Jayden Clay, and their church membership is at the Forks of Dix River Baptist Church, where Jonathan teaches Sunday School.
