Mr. Turner also participates with his brother in farming operations that include 160 acres in Madison County and 50 acres in Garrard County. Turner is a native of Garrard County.

Shane is active in many farm and professional organizations. During his service with Ag Credit, he became one of the association’s first accredited rural appraisers and then progressed to become the (past) president of the Bluegrass Chapter of the American Society of Farm Managers and Rural Appraisers. He continues to be a member of that society and is a state-certified general appraiser; he holds membership in the Madison County Beef Cattle Association and in the Kentucky Cattlemen’s Association; and is a member of the Lexington-Bluegrass Association of Realtors.

Mr. Turner and his wife, Sarah, reside in Lexington and are parents of three children. Shane earned his B.A. Degree in Business Administration with an emphasis in Marketing from Eastern Kentucky University, and later earned his Master of Business Administration Degree from that same university.
